*Cathie Nicoll served in IVCF staff for 51 years and was instrumental in the development of Pioneer Camps across Canada. She also received the Order of Canada for her life long devotion to youth. Pioneer Pacific is fortunate to have a Trust in Cathie's name that enables 1 – 2 young people a year to spend a summer at camp in a leadership capacity.*

## **Qualifications for applicants**

1. Must be an active Christian.
2. Be at least 18 years of age.
3. Have already demonstrated qualities of leadership and show potential for further development.
4. Be available for 9 weeks for the camping season at Pioneer Pacific Camp.
5. Be prepared to show leadership within Inter-Varsity Christian Fellowship or Pioneer Camps sometime within the next 2 years. (Our preference would be in the area of camper follow-up).
6. Have a recent Criminal Record Check that meets with the standards of Pioneer Pacific Camp.

## **Outline of training experience.**

1. The Ministries Director/Assistant Ministries Director will oversee the program.
2. While at camp supervisor(s) and recipient will meet together on a regular basis to:
  - a) discuss areas of leadership, job descriptions, and set goals
  - b) complete weekly evaluations
  - c) discuss Training workbook
  - d) pray together.
3. The Training Program provides planned exposure to all facets of camp living, e.g. kitchen, camp management, office, team leaders, program and work crew.
4. The recipient will give leadership by:
  - a) Learning and/or leading a Bible Study.
  - b) Cabin Leading
  - c) Teaching skills, and if possible learning a new skill.
  - d) Section and/or program leading – relating both to fellow leaders and campers.
5. Where possible the recipient should participate in pre-camp planning, i.e. Orientation programs, and a public relations event to meet parents of campers.

## **Responsibilities:**

Recipients must:

- ❖ Set goals
- ❖ Complete the Training Program Workbook.
- ❖ Submit a 2 page typed report on the summer experience
- ❖ Submit a hand-written Thank You Card to the donor and place it in an unsealed envelope.

## Criminal Record Check Information For Staff and Volunteers

Note: You will need to go in person to your local RCMP or police station and fill in the Criminal Record check form (level 4, including the vulnerable sector section) in order to allow you to work with children. The cost varies for non-profits (\$0-\$50 cash), and there is generally no charge for volunteers. The police will mail it directly to the camp. The camp address is at the bottom of this form. Be sure to bring 2 pieces of I.D, Please submit this form ASAP, as it must be returned to the camp before you can volunteer or work.
